



Total population (2012)	10,174,000

Life expectancy at birth m/f (years, 2012)	61/64
Probability of dying under five (per 1 000 live births, 2012)	76
Probability of dying between 15 and 60 years m/f (per 1 000 population, 2012)	268/227
Total expenditure on health per capita (Intl \$, 2011)	94
Total expenditure on health as % of GDP (2011)	7.9

- 78 % of the population live below the poverty line.
- 54 % of the population live in extreme poverty
- Maternal Mortality rate: 630 deaths/per 100,000 births (highest in the region)
- Only 58 % of newborns were vaccinated against measles.
- 30 % of children suffer from chronic malnutrition
- 58 % of the population does not have access to potable water.




